#### Introduction

Clarendon Heritage is planning the renovation of Chapel 1871, located in the North Clarendon Village. The goal is to repurpose the building into a Community Space that will be open to members of town.

### **Purpose**

The RFP describes in detail what the work entails in order to create a fair and precise process.

# **Scope of Work**

The scope of work will include:

- Job 1. Clean and paint tin ceiling in main room.
- Job 2. Refinish the floor in main room with tile and carpet.
- Job 3 Repair wood damage on the exterior of the building
- Job 4. Repair glass of front 2 rooms.
- Job 5. Add plexiglass protection to the current windows in main room and front 2 rooms/
- Job 6. Painting the exterior of the building and the belfry. (See Guidelines at: https://www.nps.gov/orgs/1739/upload/preservation-brief-28-painting-interiors.pdf).
- Job 7.
- A. Create a handicap entrance at the back of the building and add 2 windows, as well as a passthrough window between main room and back room, on the left of the furnace wall.
- B. Finishing the backroom with drywall and enclosing furnace, and a pass-through window on the left of the furnace wall.
- C. Install a standard sink and counter.
- Job 8. Add an incinerator type toilet and sink.
- Job 9. Repaint the interior and backroom with a standard museum color and front door in a separate color.
- Job 10. Refinish two front rooms.
- Job 11. Restore damaged windows (by a historic window restorer).
- Contractors or vendors are welcome to bid on one or more jobs.

#### **Qualifications**

These jobs should be accomplished by properly vetted and insured contractors that understand the significance of historical preservation and have a demonstrated track record restoring historic buildings.

## **Budget**

Total budget: \$87,000

# **Bid and Selection Dates**

All final proposals are due by January 15th, 2026, and will be reviewed by February 15th, 2026. Final selection will be made public March 1st, 2026.
